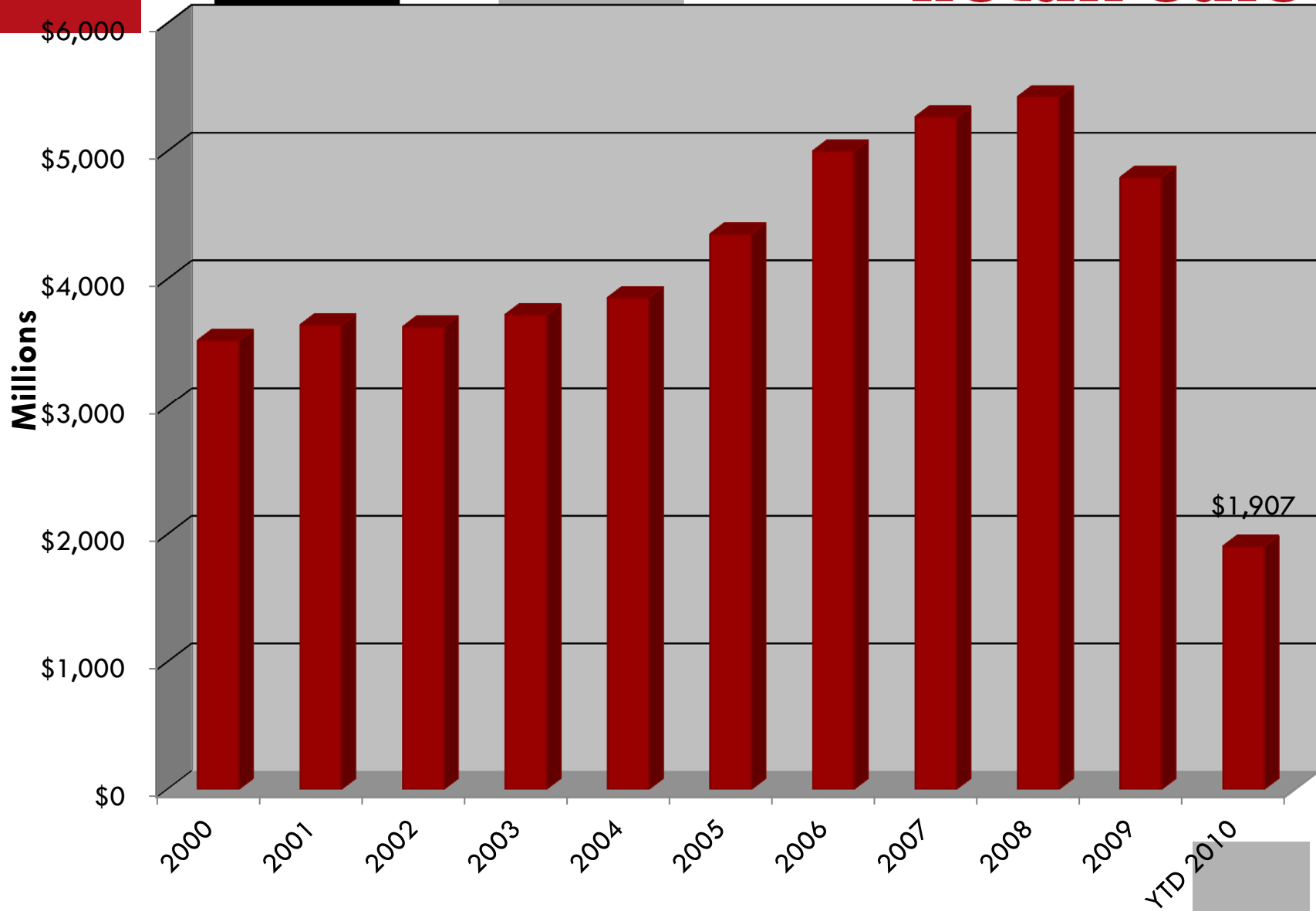

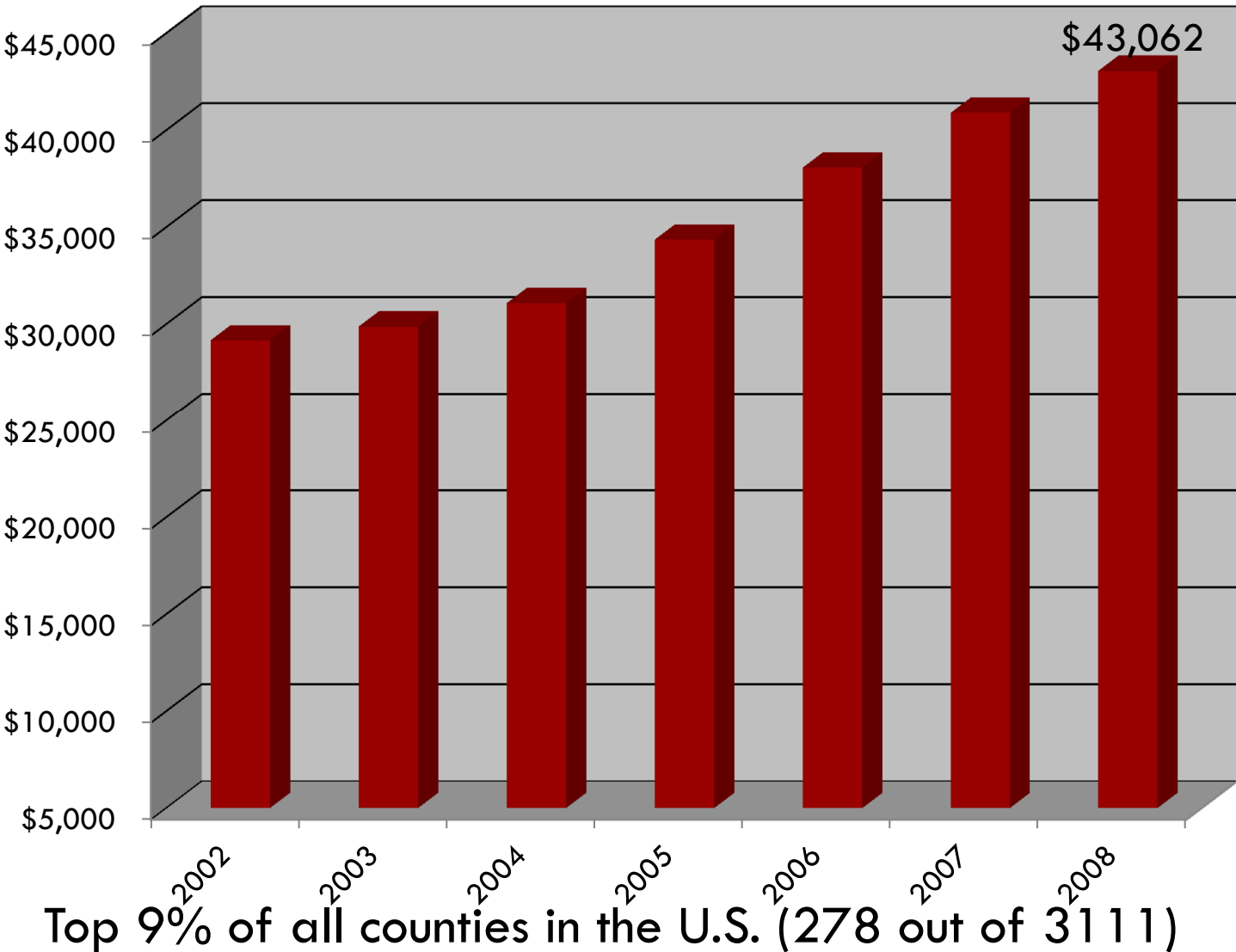

Per Capita Income

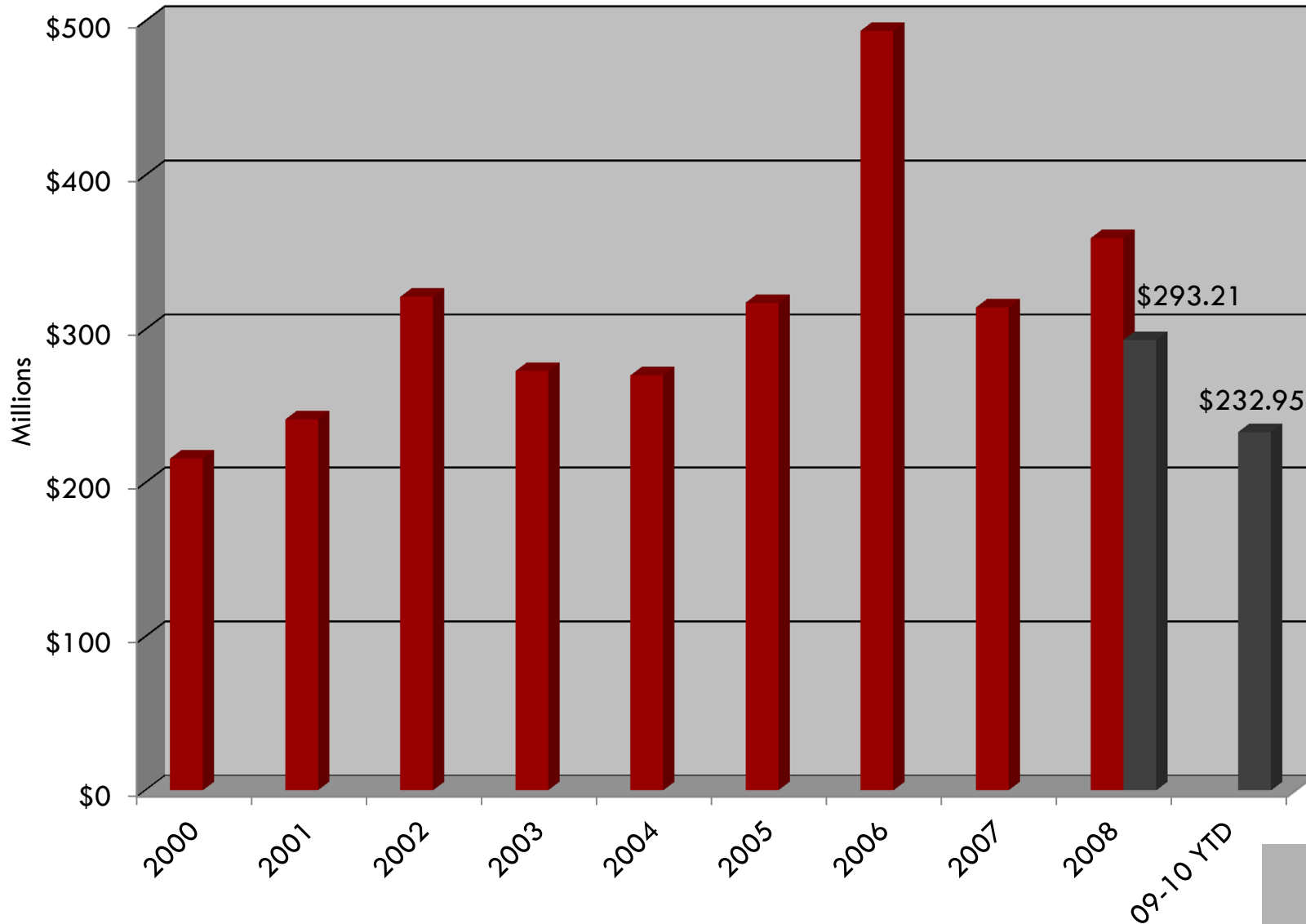


Lafayette's PCI increased 3.8% from 2007 to 2008.

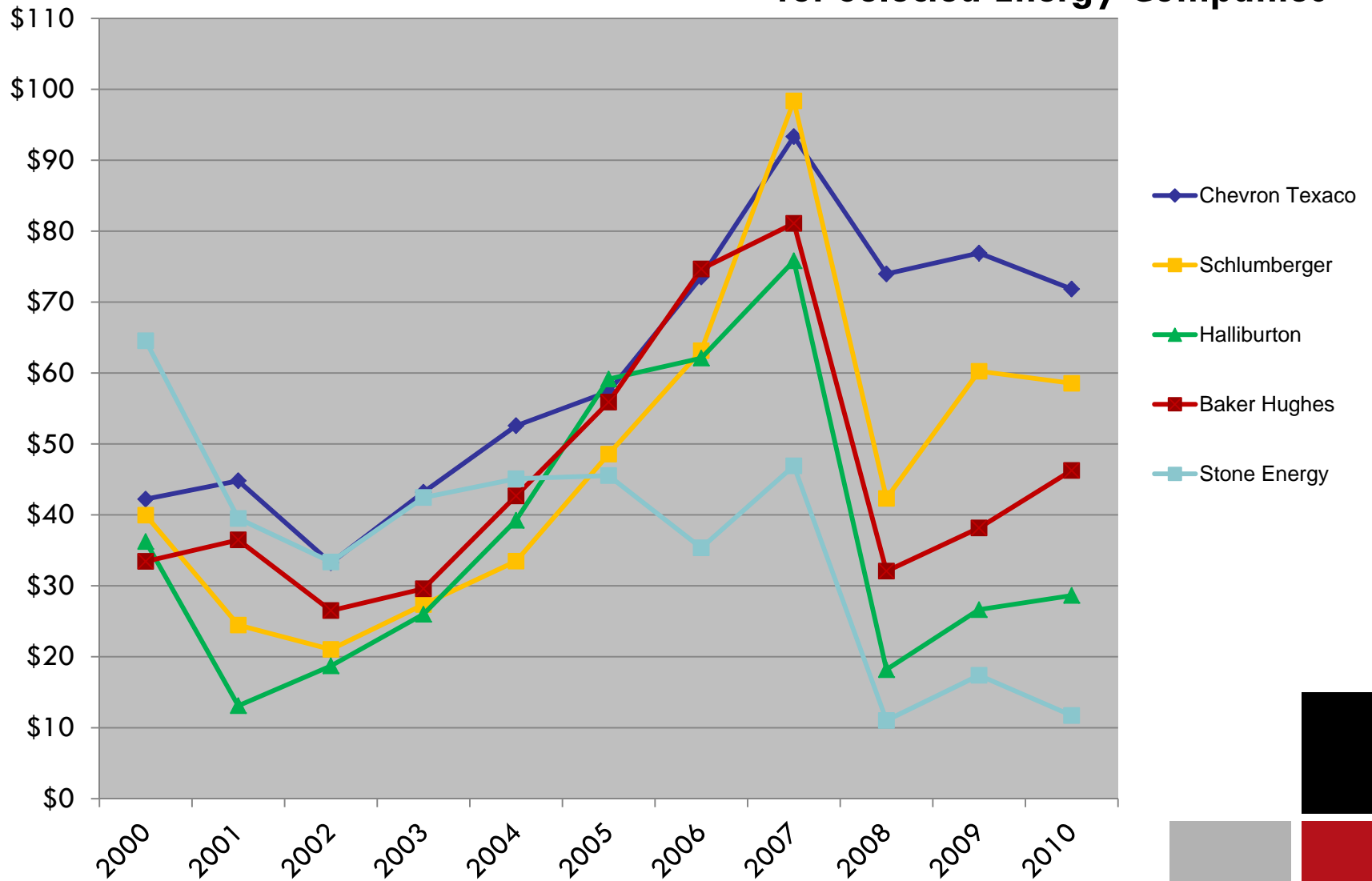
Construction Valuation
